From Cold Nights to Warm, Hopeful Futures

David and Shauna looked around their new apartment, feeling immense gratitude to Catholic Charities NH donors for transforming their lives. From cold, sleepless nights filled with fear and hopelessness, they now have a warm roof over their heads, access to enough food, and peace of mind knowing that everything will be okay.

For two years, these high school sweethearts lived in a small, used van, despite both having full-time jobs. Their home was a makeshift shelter with a bed, a tiny fridge, and their belongings packed in bags. Saving money was a constant struggle.

Eventually, the van broke down, and repairing it was too costly. When a leak formed in the van's roof, a tattered tarp became their only shield against the harsh New Hampshire winters. To stay warm, they used a portable propane heater, cracked open windows and relied on a carbon monoxide detector for safety. Most nights, they lay awake, worrying whether they would see the morning.

Shauna finally found an affordable apartment, but they could only gather half of the security deposit. Desperate, they called Catholic Charities NH, a call that changed everything.

Thanks to compassionate donors, David and Shauna worked with our Community Services program and received the remaining balance needed to move into the apartment. Catholic Charities NH provided furniture, connected them with a local food pantry, and facilitated further rental and utility assistance. They also received financial literacy training, which enabled them to create a sustainable budget for a secure future.

Today, David and Shauna sleep peacefully in their warm apartment, their dreams no longer haunted by fear and uncertainty. Your support created ripples of positive change that will continue to spread for years to come.

"If it wasn't for Catholic Charities NH, we would still be in that broken van, getting soaked and taking desperate measures just to stay warm. People like you are amazing - always there to help and doing everything you can to get people's lives back on track." - David

An Improbable, Incredible Journey

Wearing a cap and gown and a big smile, Misty Rodriguez strode confidently across the stage to receive her nursing diploma as her family loudly cheered her on. This was her dream come true—a dream made possible by generous donors like you.

It was also a moment she never thought possible when she first reached out to Catholic Charities for help, 27 years ago, homeless and pregnant at age 15.

Desperately in need of guidance, Misty entered the Our Place pregnancy and parenting education program and received the support she needed to give birth to a healthy baby boy. Learning to safely care for her child was a big part of her continued participation in the program, but Our Place also helped her discover opportunities to move forward and create a better life for her and her son.


Our Place helped Misty access two Catholic Charities grants to earn her GED and her Licensed Nursing Assistant (LNA) certificate, which led to a job at St. Teresa Rehabilitation and Nursing Center (operated by Catholic Charities NH). This new role gave her the income to bring her out of poverty.

A few years later, Misty's husband faced an immigration issue. They received help from Catholic Charities' Immigration Legal Services team to keep her family together – a family that grew to include four children – with her husband eventually becoming a US citizen.

Catholic Charities once more intersected Misty's life three years ago when she learned about our donor-supported Pathways scholarship and the opportunity to become a nurse at last. Misty applied for the scholarship and was accepted, completing the Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) program a year later.

With a diploma in hand, Misty thought back to that day in 1997, when she first arrived at Our Place, and the amazing sequence of events that brought her to where she is today – ripples of change, thanks to donors like you.

"Catholic Charities was the only organization I found that could help. I'm so thankful for the donors from years ago to today – it's more than a donation, it's changing a life. I'll be forever grateful." – Misty





Mother & Son Forge a New Beginning

Tears of joy. Because of your support, Spenser was getting her son back.

Twelve months earlier, Spenser had given birth to her son Colton. Homeless throughout her pregnancy and with a history of substance misuse, she arrived at the hospital having relapsed a few days before. Doctors soon discovered drugs in her system and Colton's as well. Colton was placed in foster care, giving Spenser one year to turn her life around and have a chance to regain custody.

After completing a seven-month drug rehabilitation program, Spenser needed a safe place in which she could continue her recovery and rebuild her life. She found New Generation, a shelter and pathway out of homelessness for pregnant women and single mothers with young children who are escaping domestic abuse, recovering from substance addiction, and facing other significant struggles.

At New Generation, the staff empowered Spenser to move forward with her life, as she set and accomplished goals, such as maintaining her sobriety, obtaining a job, and pursuing housing.

When Spenser appeared in court seeking custody, she was a changed person. She acknowledged past mistakes and stated her readiness to reunite with Colton – the result of the support she received and the work she put in at New Generation.

Soon after the judge ruled in her favor and Colton returned, Spenser secured permanent housing and moved into an apartment - the two of them finally had a place they could call home.

Spenser has since joined the team at New Generation, helping other moms rebuild their lives, ensuring the ripples of change that you made possible for her now impact even more women and children.

"New Generation is such a huge support, and a big part of getting my son back. Thank you very much to the donors - I've had so much help from people I don't know and I'm *just so grateful."* – Spenser

A Veteran's Second Chance

Michael has become himself again. Because of your support, he is again a man with a sense of purpose, which had been missing for over a decade due to the horrors of war, but was rekindled when Liberty House opened its doors to him.

An IED ambush in Afghanistan nearly killed Michael, leaving many of his fellow soldiers dead and him with deep physical and emotional scars. Diagnosed with traumatic brain injury and Post Traumatic Stress, he eventually received a medical discharge after 25 years of service in the United States Army – service that earned him a Bronze Star and Purple Heart from his multiple combat tours.

Transitioning to civilian life only made things worse. The flashbacks, the what-if's, and the nightmares persisted. In an attempt to numb the pain, Michael turned to drugs and alcohol, which cost him his family and even led to incarceration. He had nowhere to turn – until he found Liberty House.

Liberty House, a program of Catholic Charities NH, provides transitional housing and basic needs assistance to help veterans like Michael get back on their feet and once again have a chance to lead purposeful and independent lives.

Through the program's 4-step program and staff support, Michael began to rebuild his life, working on his recovery, obtaining essential documents, connecting with mental health counseling and setting goals to build a career he's excited about. The result is powerful – he's now working as a Certified Recovery Support Worker (CRSW), helping fellow veterans who are struggling.

Your support created the ripples of change that restored the life of an American hero.

"Thanks to Liberty House and all the donors of Catholic Charities, I have that sense of purpose again. It's such a humbling experience to know that people from all walks of life will help somebody like me when I was at my darkest point." – Michael




Your Support Created Lasting Impact

Because of you, Catholic Charities NH has been able to transform hundreds of lives across New Hampshire this year. Your support provided the essential resources, compassionate support, and empowering guidance to help individuals and families overcome their darkest days and build bright, promising futures.

You restored the dignity and independence of veterans facing housing instability, post-traumatic stress and other major challenges

- 5,472 collective nights of shelter provided through Liberty House's substance-free transitional living program.
- 44,621 items of food, clothing and other essentials distributed through Liberty House's community pantry.
- 15 residents secured meaningful employment.




You helped homebound and isolated seniors ensure they can get to critical medical appointments, have enough food in their homes, and know they are never alone.

- 128,380 pounds of food delivered through the CareGivers Caring Cupboard program.
- 19,979 miles driven to medical appointments, the grocery store and other vital errands through the CareGivers Caring Rides program.
- 106 seniors took part in social programs and received assistance for everyday needs through Monadnock at Home.

You brought healing to those struggling with emotional pain and difficult situations.

- 2,045 mental health counseling sessions conducted.
- 86% of clients reported improvements in their overall quality of life.
- 93% of individuals noted a reduction in symptoms related to their challenges.





You helped ensure mothers and children no longer have to worry about having nowhere to live.

- 6,545 collective nights of shelter provided at New Generation.
- 90 children and 59 mothers received support services to overcome homelessness and build self-sufficiency.

You gave small children the keys to a safe and nurturing environment where they can thrive.

- **194 children** benefited from the pregnancy and parenting education their parents received through the Our Place program.
- 97% of parents noted improvements in their parenting knowledge, and 98% reported increased self-sufficiency.





You created sustainable solutions for individuals and families overwhelmed by poverty or a lack of basic life needs.

- 8,559 individuals benefited from case management, financial literacy training, and other forms of support through Community Services.
- 20,555 collective days of housing preserved for individuals and families through energy/fuel, electricity, and shelter assistance.

Misty Rodriguez (St. Teresa), Susan Rindoria (Mt. Carmel), and Nicole Arris (Mt. Carmel) all earned their Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) degrees through Pathways, which provides scholarship opportunities for healthcare professionals to advance their careers.

The donor-supported Pathways program also offers financial support for entry-level candidates pursuing Licensed Nursing Assistant (LNA) certifications and select scholarships for LPNs aiming to become Registered Nurses (RN).



CCNH's Mardi Gras Dazzles in Community Goodwill

February 10 was a night to remember as the 18th Annual Mardi Gras Gala took center stage in Concord. The evening featured New Orleansinspired cuisine, lively dancing, and an array of entertainment that kept attendees celebrating well into the night for an incredible cause.

Mardi Gras raised \$222,000 in net proceeds to support Catholic Charities NH programs, which bring positive change to thousands of NH residents annually. A Morning to Honor Our Veterans

The 9th Annual Veterans Day Breakfast provided a perfect opportunity to pay tribute to veterans who have made great sacrifices for our country and way of life. On November 4, attendees gathered at LaBelle Winery to hear inspirational stories, including those from two Korean War veterans and a resident of Liberty House.

The event raised over \$38,000 to support Liberty House, which offers a sober residential program and community pantry for veterans dealing with homelessness, PTSD, and other challenges.

CCNH Skilled Nursing Facilities Honored Nationally

Five Catholic Charities NH skilled nursing facilities once again received national honors with a 2024 Customer Experience Award from Pinnacle Quality Insight, recognizing the highest national standards in patient and resident experience.

Mt. Carmel Rehabilitation and Nursing Center (Manchester), St. Ann Rehabilitation and Nursing Center (Dover), St. Francis Rehabilitation and Nursing Center (Laconia), St. Teresa Rehabilitation and Nursing Center (Manchester), and Warde Senior Living (Windham) were consistently in the top 15% of care providers nationwide over the past year.


This marks the second consecutive year that Catholic Charities NH and these facilities have earned this distinction, with the five facilities being among only six providers statewide to receive this honor this year




- Continue to work with NH healthcare organizations to screen for food insecurity using The Hunger Vital Sign™.
